Presentation: Tamil Nadu

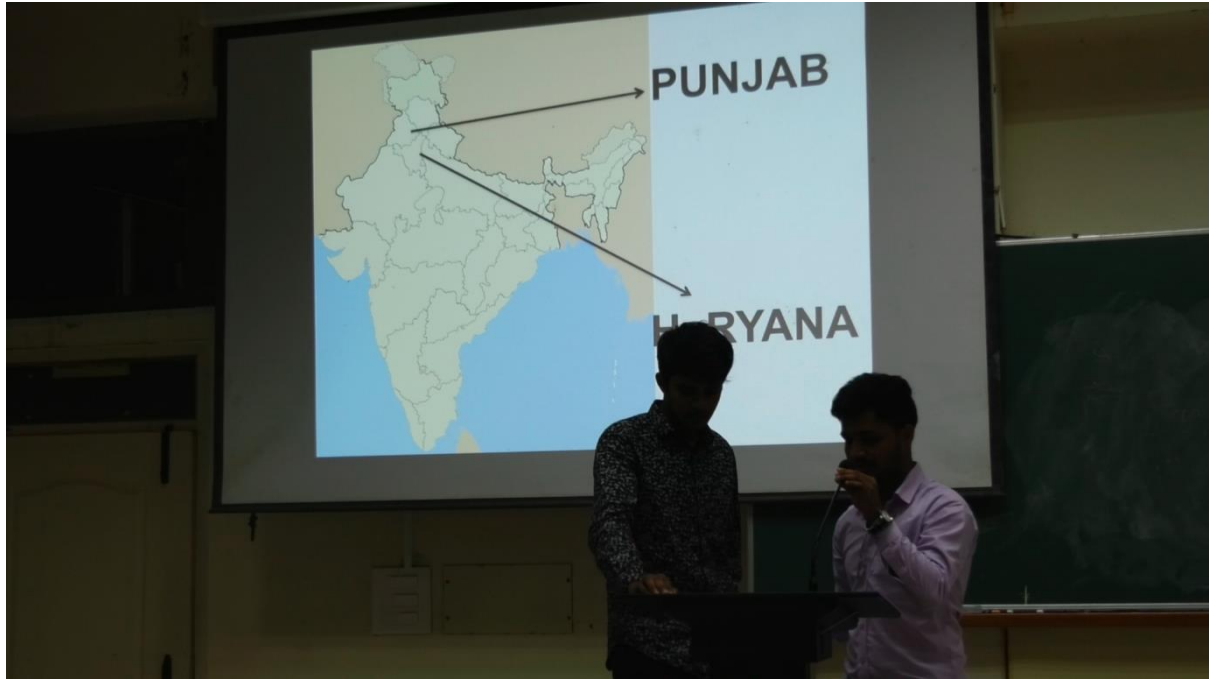
