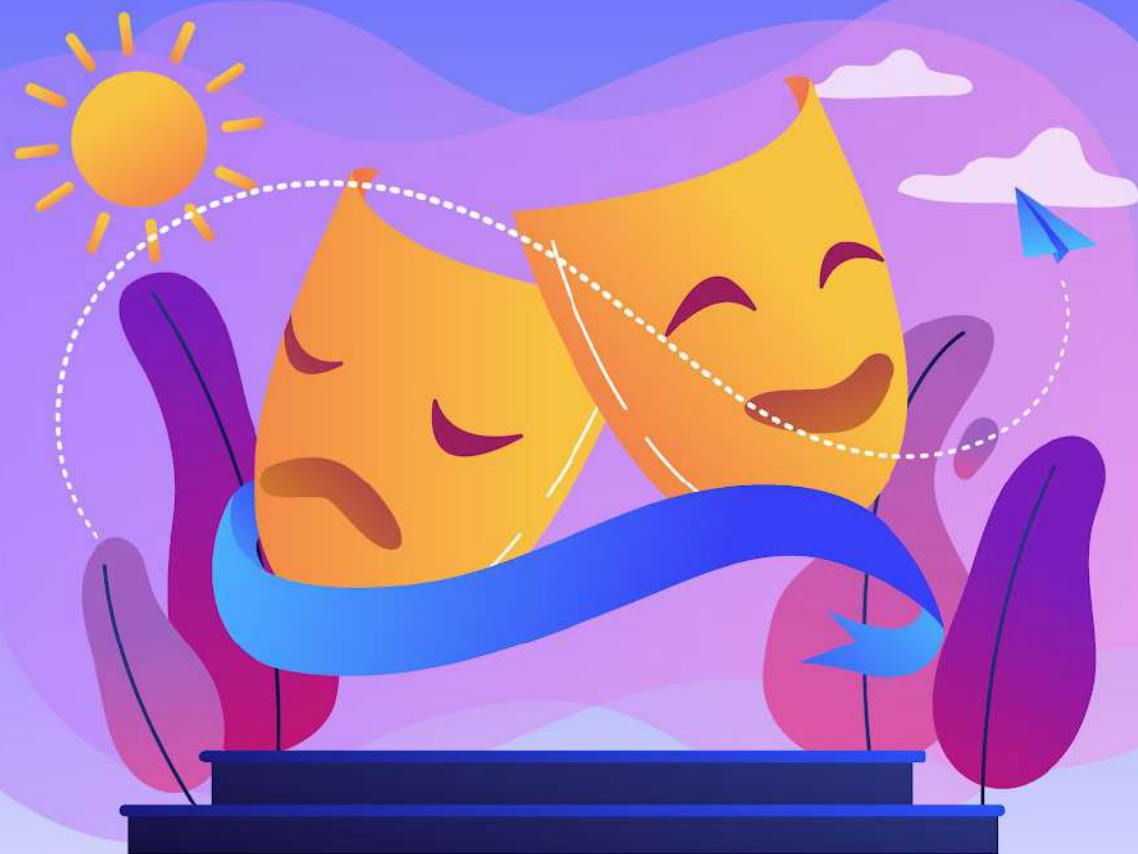

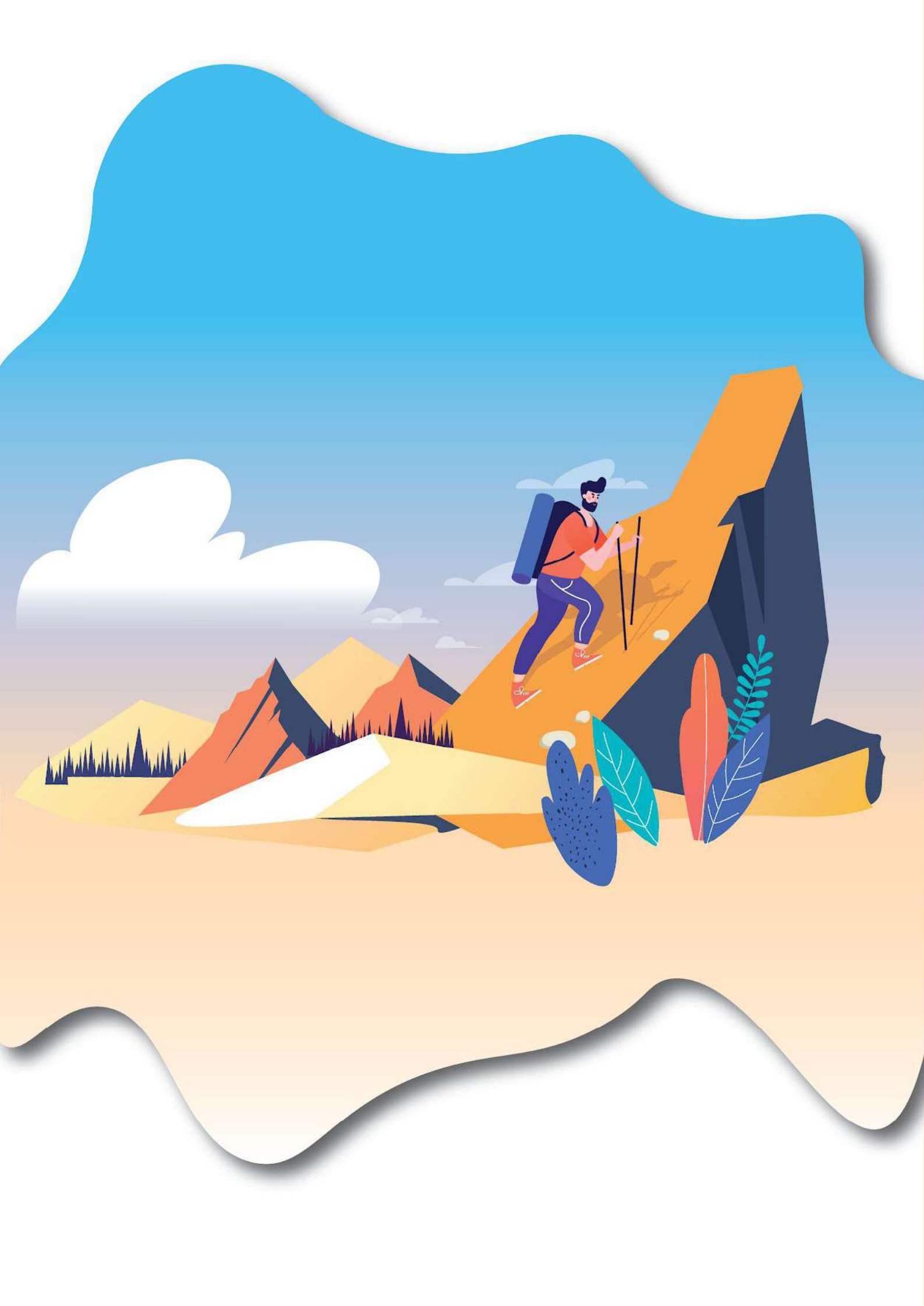

There are various posts in the Alumni Cell. The posts are open to all, each having its own requirements, which will be communicated to students as and when they open up. An interview process may be there for selection.

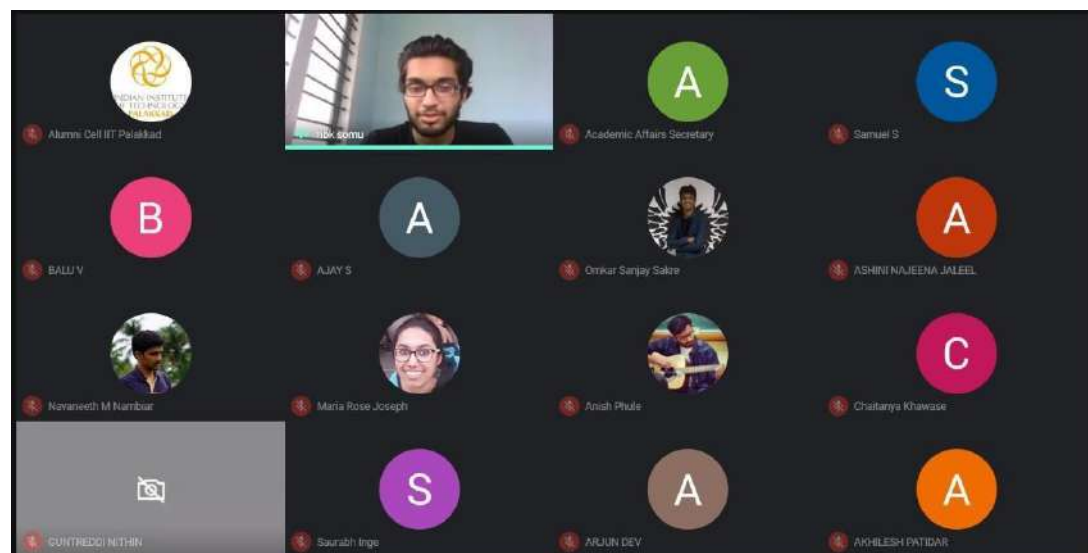

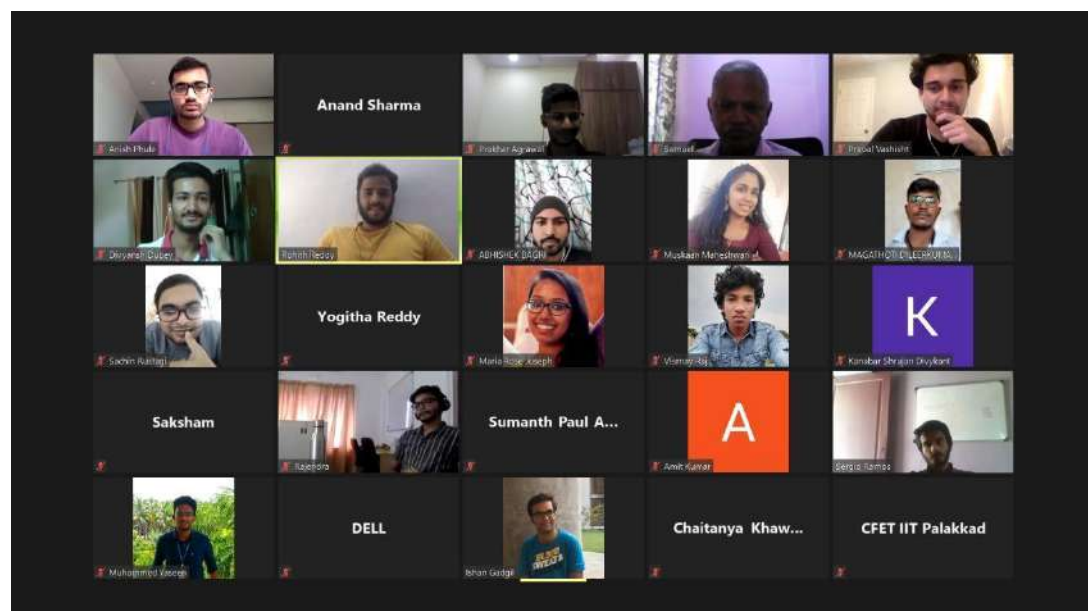

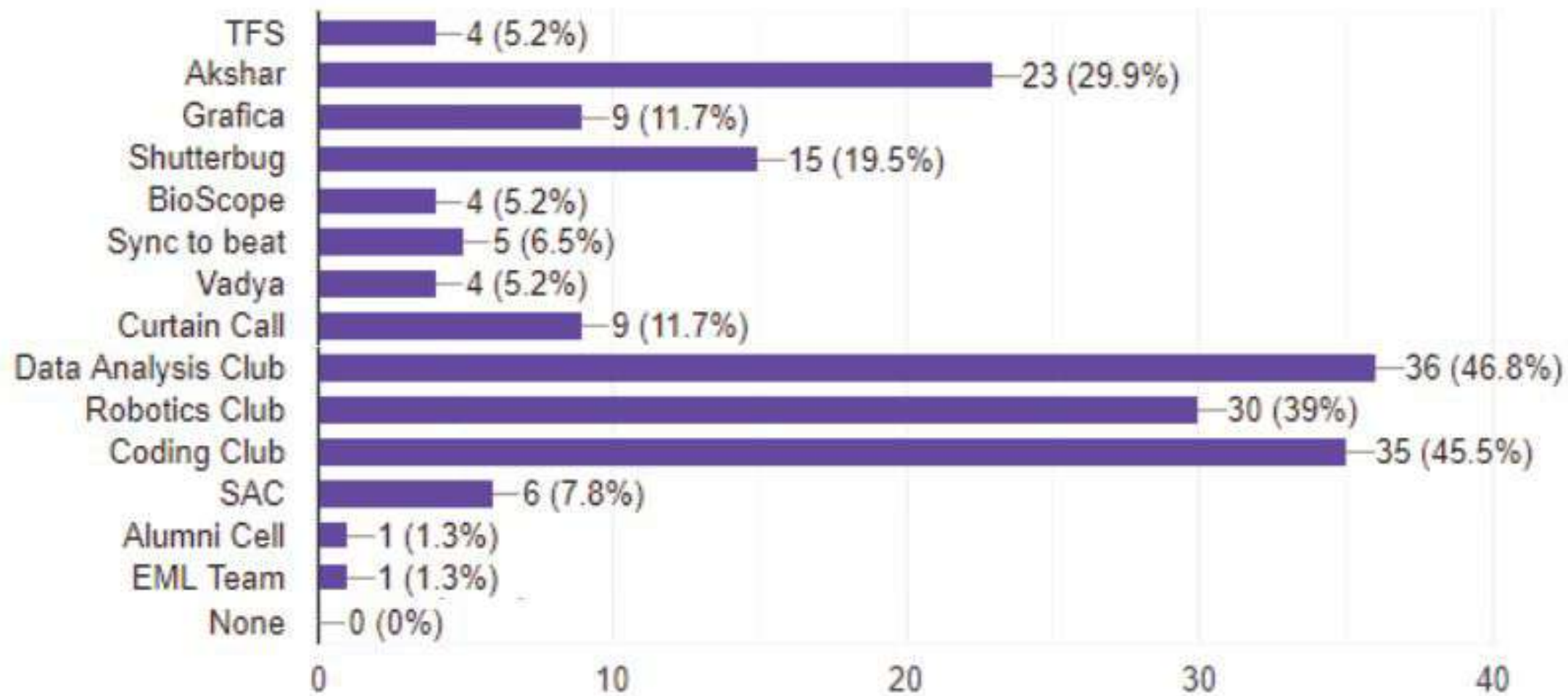

Survey on Participation in Student Bodies



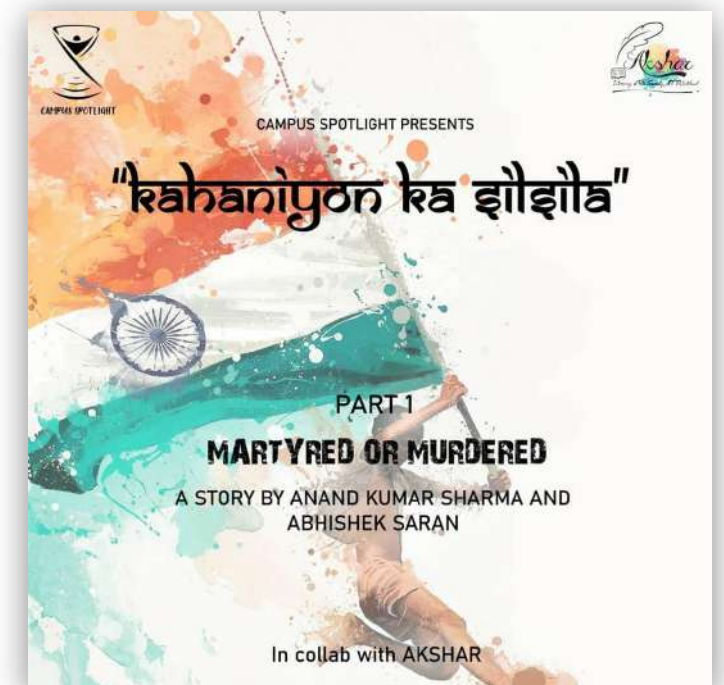
